### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS

- The College login will be closed after the last date.
- Principals are requested not to forward/submit the EAF of Not Eligible Candidates. The results of Not Eligible candidates will be cancelled at any stage, if they write the examination.

#### **NOTE:-**

1. The Principal is requested to send the **Faculty list** without which the examination forms will not be accepted.
2. In respect of the candidates who have completed the course requirement having completed Semester and not completed (2+2) years are eligible to apply. Candidates who were admitted during the academic year **(2021-2022) eligible with Rs.1000/- for each paper.** However prior to 2020 batch candidates are not eligible.

3. The Principal is requested to verify the eligibility of the students thoroughly and forward the same to this office for the issue of Hall Ticket. If failed to verify the eligibility of the candidates, the principal is held responsible for the issue of hall ticket by this office to the non-eligible candidates.

**Application Forms submitted after 03-04-2025 will have to pay a Penal fee of Rs. 1200/- per day.**

4. The Principal may kindly forward all the examination application forms online through College login.
5. As a part of the Core Banking System, all the students are hereby instructed to deposit the Examination Fee into their respective college accounts only for onward transmission to the University by the college.
6. Not to collect the Exam fee from Blind, Physically Disabled, Deaf & Dumb students as per O.U. Order No. 1555/228/2007-08/Budget-V, dated: 25-03-2008. A Xerox copy of medical Certificate confirming their status as Handicapped (minimum percentage of disability must be of 40% attached to the application forms. Blind, Physically Disabled, Deaf & Dumb student's applications forms should be submitted separately along with separate Nominal Roll.
7. Any discrepancies with regards to the Candidate data such as Internal marks, Practical, Viva-voce and Projects etc. should be brought to the notice of concerned officials of Examination Branch and obtain the acknowledgement within one month of declaration of results. After one month, queries will not be entertained.
